Free Computer Access

Quorn School Community Library has a number of computers available for community use, with programs including Word, Access and Publisher. Printing is available- please see staff for current costs. Please bring your own disks and/ or USB if you wish to save your work.

Free Internet Access

Two 'Public Net' computers are available free to the public for Internet access. Patrons under 18 years of age require parental permission. Please see staff for costing of printouts. Patrons may ensure access by booking sessions with library staff, in person or by phone (08) 8648 6101.

Hear-a-books

Hear-a-books are stories recorded on cassettes or CDs. They suit people who have difficulty reading print, who enjoy listening to stories while driving, going to sleep, etc. Titles are available for monthly loan.

Inter-Library Loans

As part of the Public Libraries SA Network, resources held in other South Australian Public Libraries may be accessed by our patrons. Ask library staff for your favourite authors, titles and/or topics. If we don't have them, we'll try to get them in for you! Resources from other Public Libraries may be returned to the library in Quorn, to be delivered free of charge.

Laminating

Library staff are happy to help you with your laminating needs. Protect your certificates, signs and other valuable documents. A3, A4, A5 and credit card sizes are available. Please see staff for prices and further information.

Local History Reference Collection

Quorn is in a district rich in history. We have copies of school registers for Quorn and the various small school communities which used to exist nearby. Burial registers, local histories and references are often useful to our patrons and are increasing in value. The majority of our Local History Collection is not for loan, but is easily accessible within the library. Our District Council, the Tourist Office and Local History Group may also be of help.

Magazines

Available for weekly loan are many magazine titles. These include Australian Geographic, National Geographic, Practical Parenting, Grass Roots, Better Homes & Gardens, Handmade and Australian Country Craft & Decorating. Come in and browse the collection.

Music CDs

We have over 100 music CDs available for two week loan. Ask library staff for the catalogue to make your selection from classical, popular, country, children's music, etc.
